Thesis Prompt: Contemporary Christians are bombarded with ideas, world views, and opinions from every direction. Today's culture promotes values that are in direct conflict with the Bible. Many of these non-biblical viewpoints are offered as solutions for the problems of the day. Many Christians, who say the Bible is their supreme authority, have adopted non-biblical viewpoints. How can a Christian tell which views are Biblical and which are not? How can Christians understand the culture of today and engage it, without forfeiting their Biblical values?

What Information to include in Paper:

- Contrast at least 4 worldviews to Christianity
- Include Biblical support for creation, absolute truth, moral values, and Christ as the only source of salvation

Summa Cum Laude Level Paper Guidelines:

- Total length: 8-12 pages, double spaced (Note: Paper can be longer if needed.)
- 12 Point Font and Times New Roman font
- 1" margins
- Numbered pages on each page of paper
- Works Cited page is required (Note: The Works Cited page does not count in the total length of the paper.)
